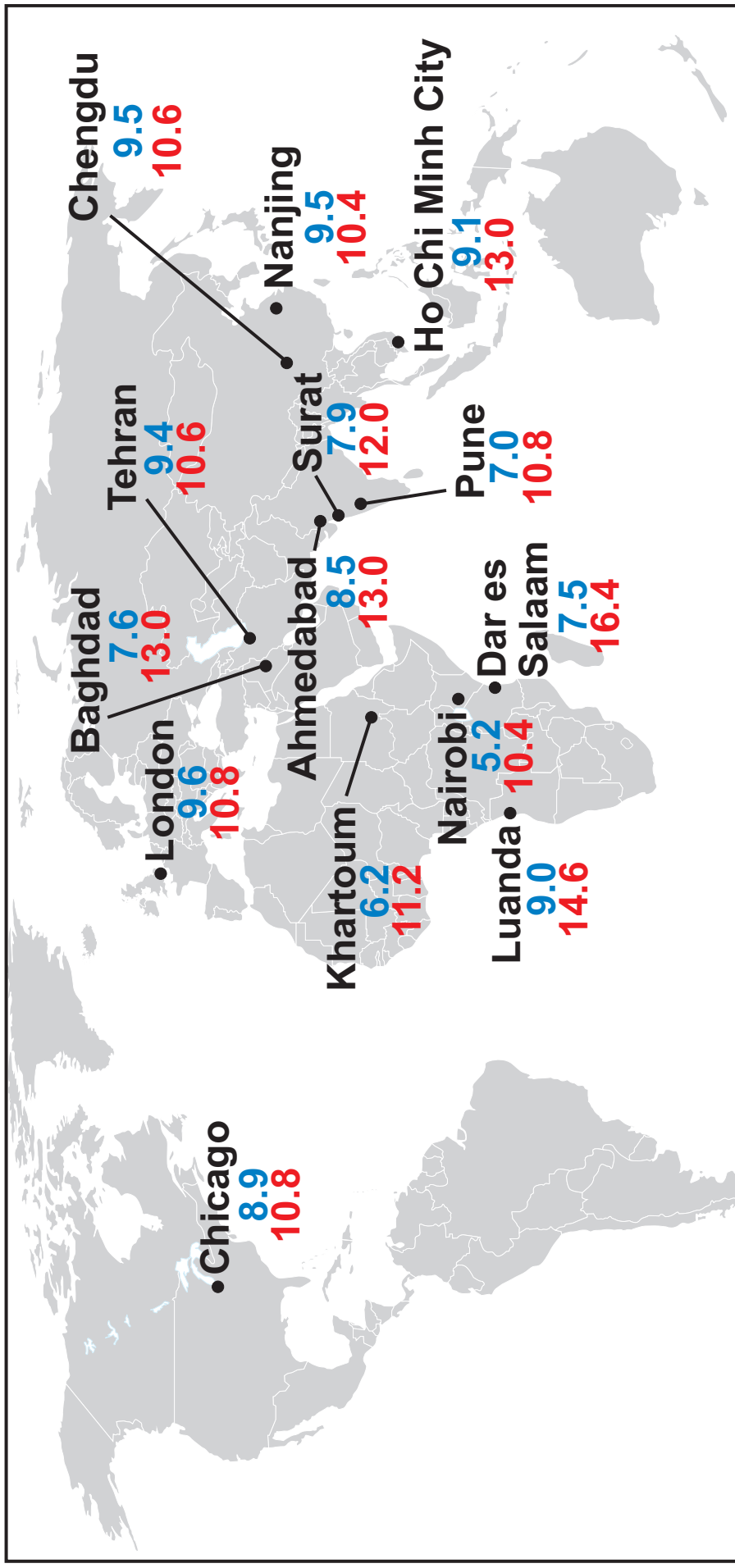

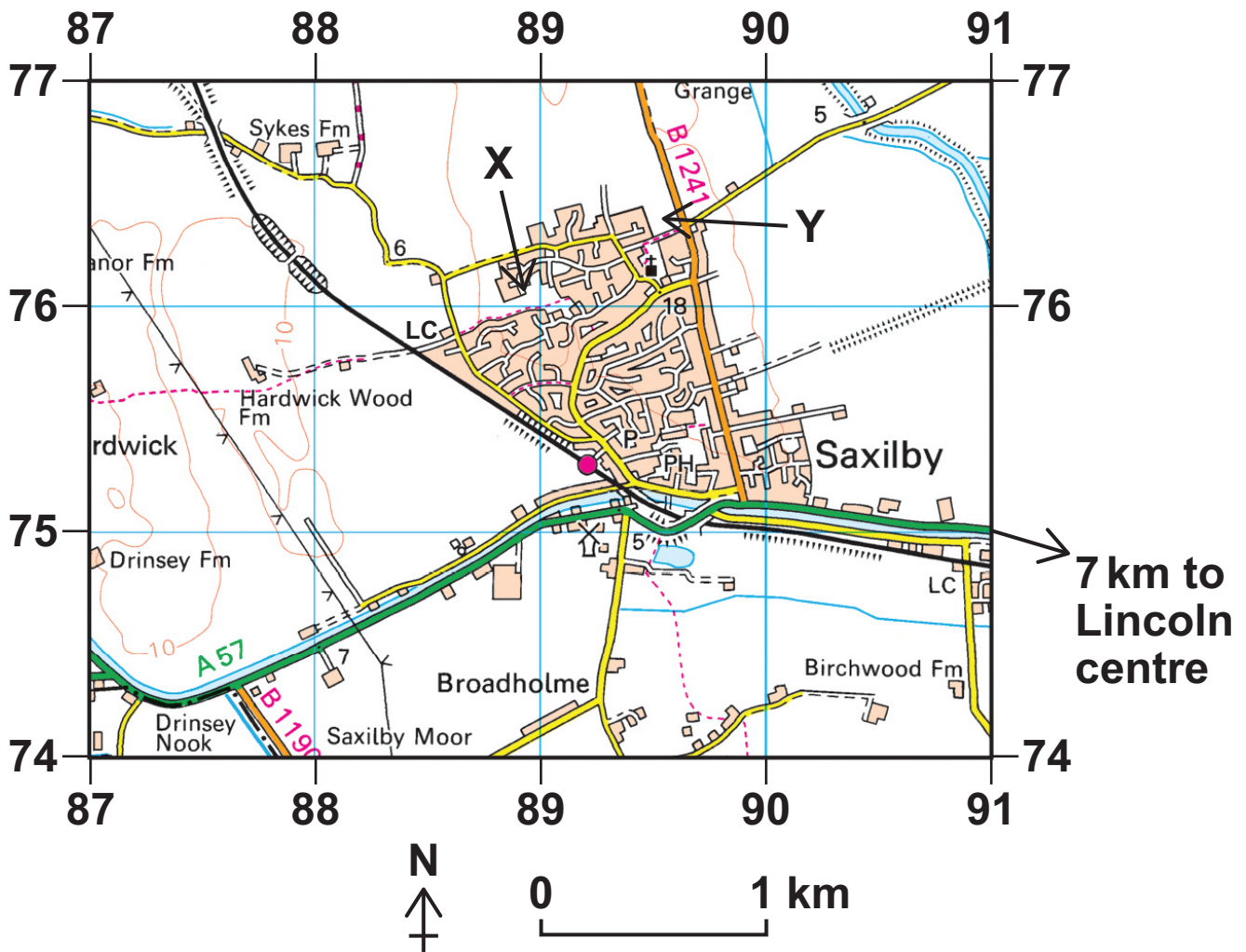


FIGURE 5 – For use with Question 1

He said that money would always be spent on projects that benefit those most in need. It is particularly important to improve sanitation in the country if they are to progress.

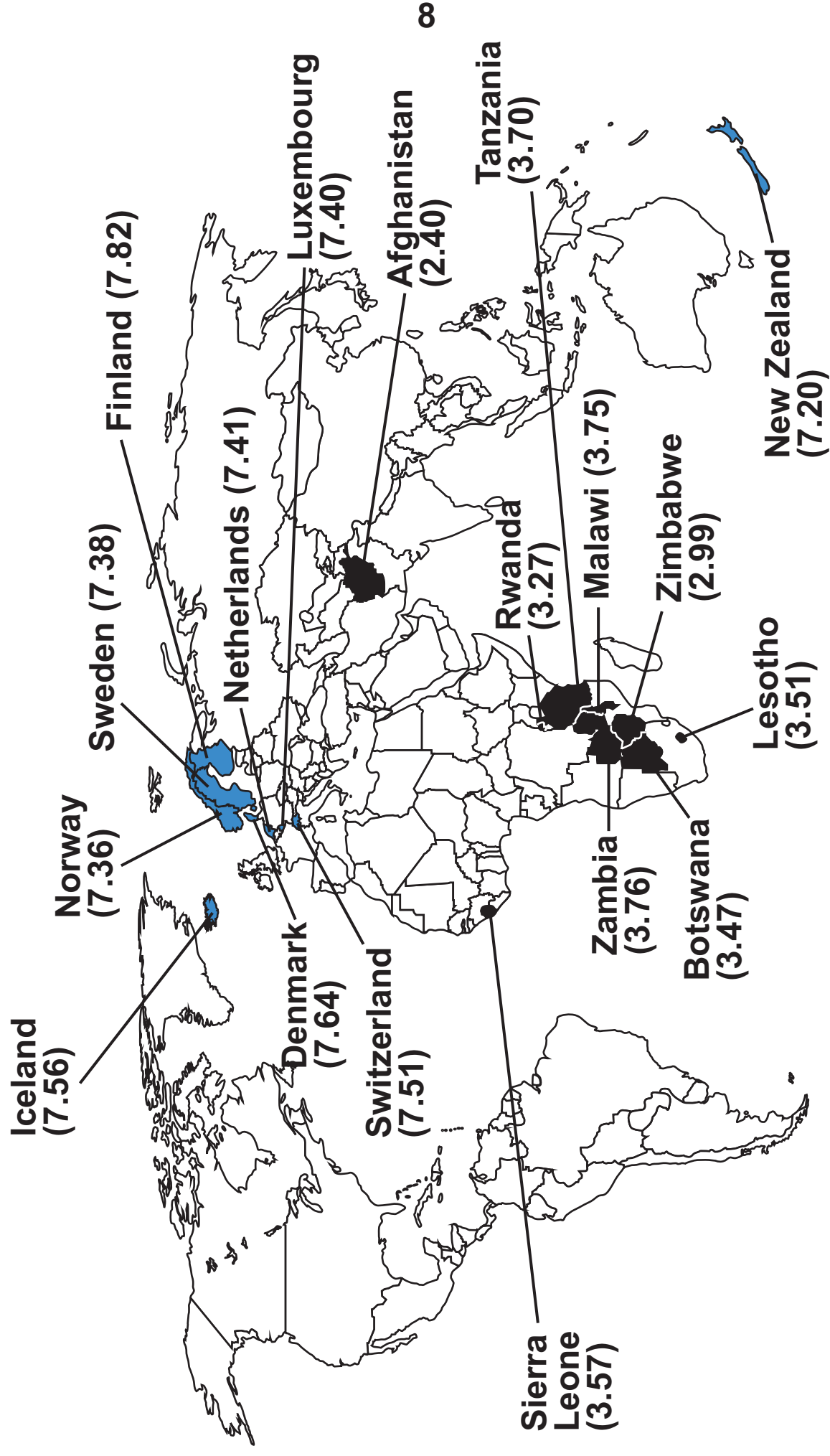
The president also stated that much work had already been done in the poorest regions and he guaranteed money for new projects to expand the availability of clean water. (April 2019)
