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Figure 1 – Median household incomes in 2021: Cleveland, Ohio & USA

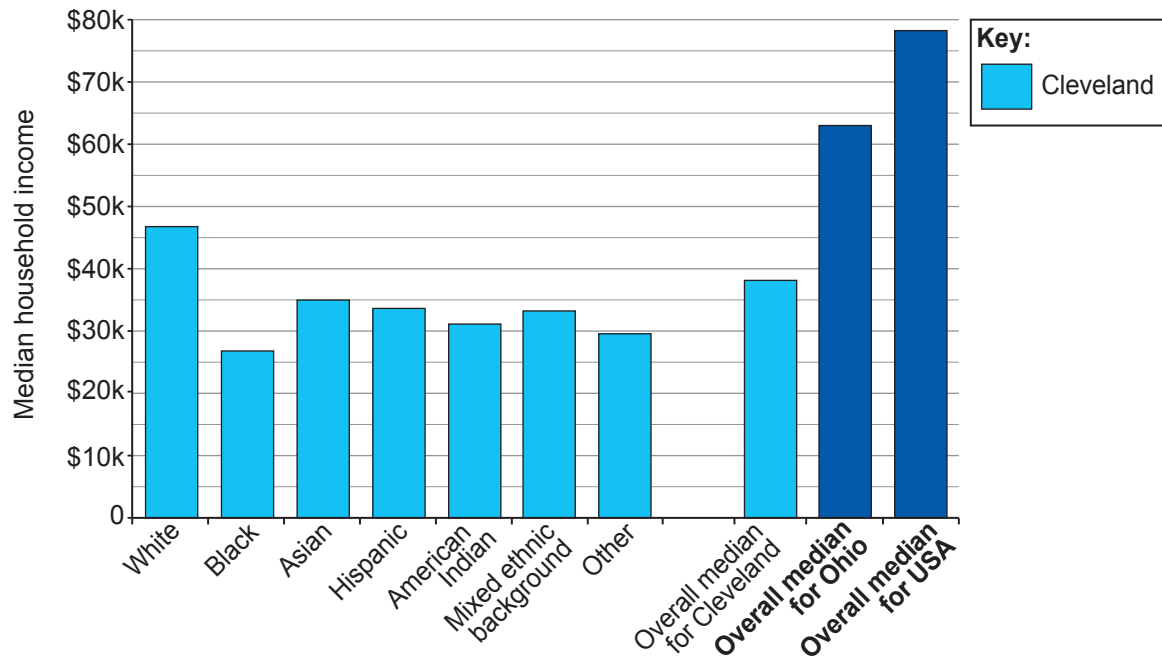


Figure 2 – The population of Cleveland, 1940–2020

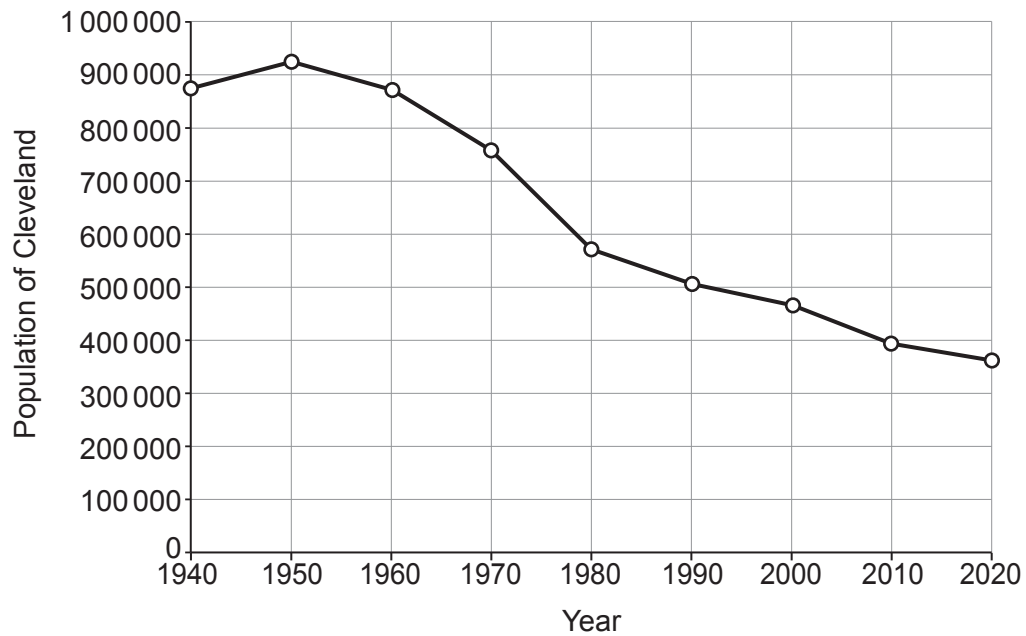
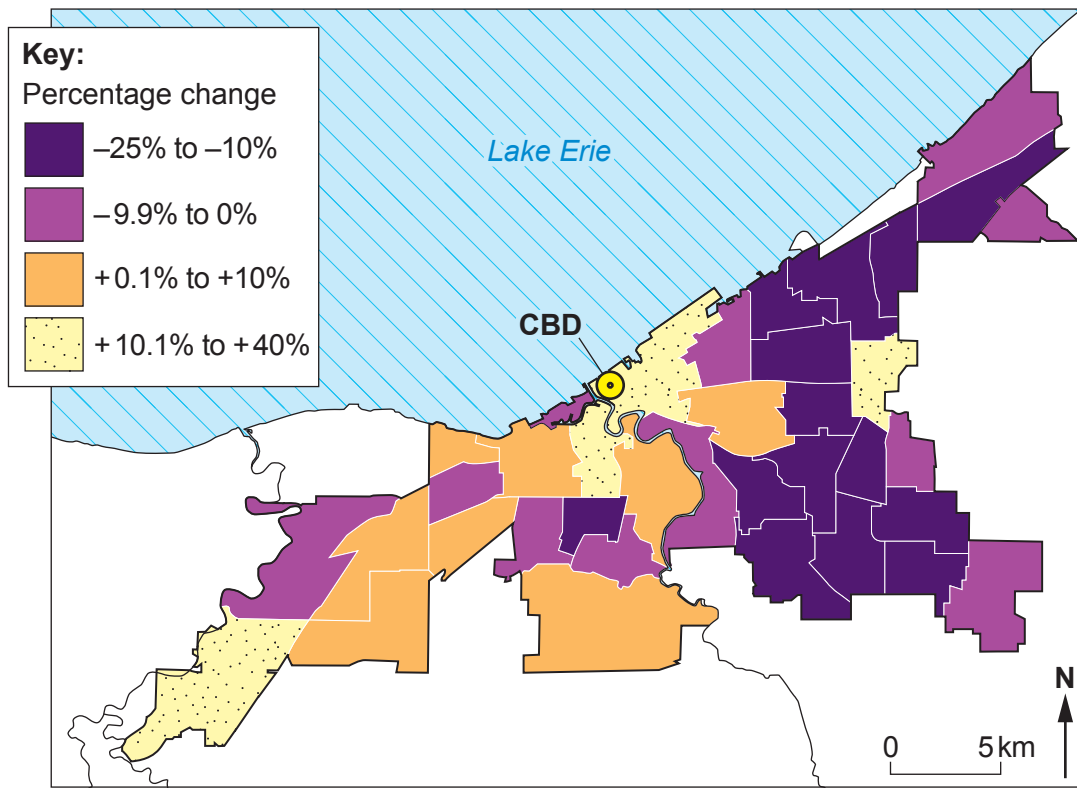


Figure 3 – Percentage population change in Cleveland, 2010–2020

Cleveland is the worst city to raise a family in, one survey says



Cleveland, Ohio

Cleveland is ranked as the worst city in the US to raise a family in, according to new survey data.

Cleveland (left) ranked last out of 182 US cities that were surveyed for the best cities to raise a family in, with a total score of 34.

The cities were measured across five categories: family fun, health and safety, education and child care, affordability and socio-economics.

Each category included even more specific criteria, including cost of living, walkability, crime rate-per-capita, average commute time, playgrounds-per-capita, air quality, and more.

In the five categories, Cleveland ranked (out of 182):

- 106th in family fun
- 160th in health and safety
- 167th in education and child care
- 168th in affordability
- 181st in socio-economics.

Figure 5 – Proportion of land use in Cleveland, Ohio, 2021

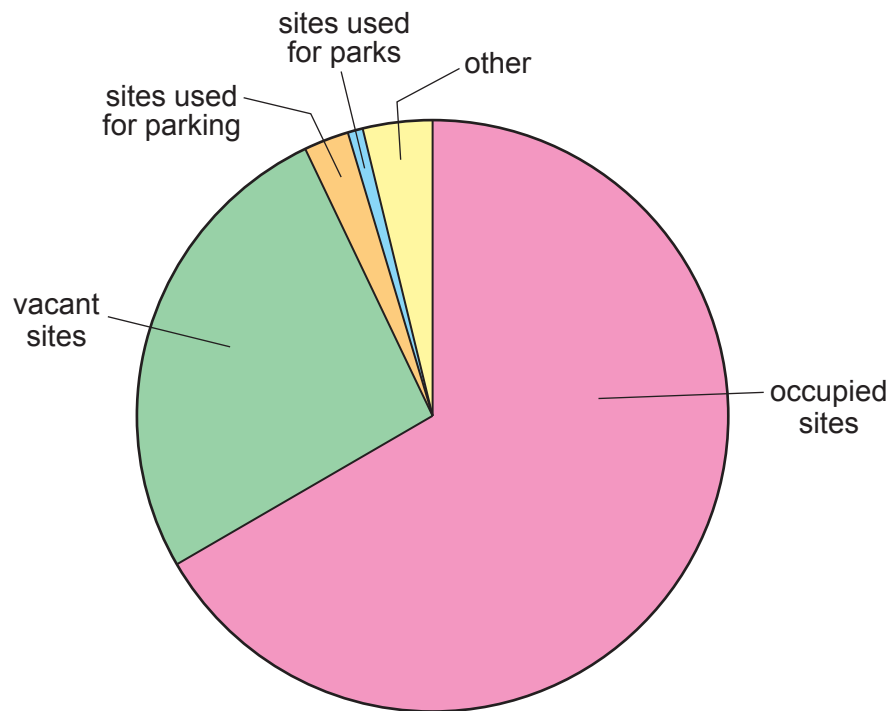


Figure 6 – Location of featured cities

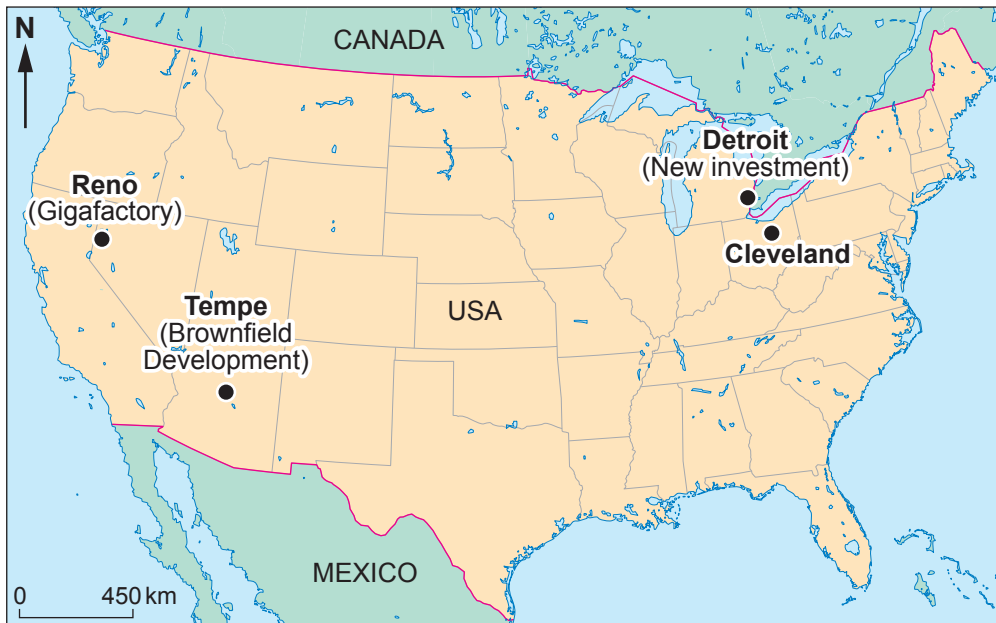
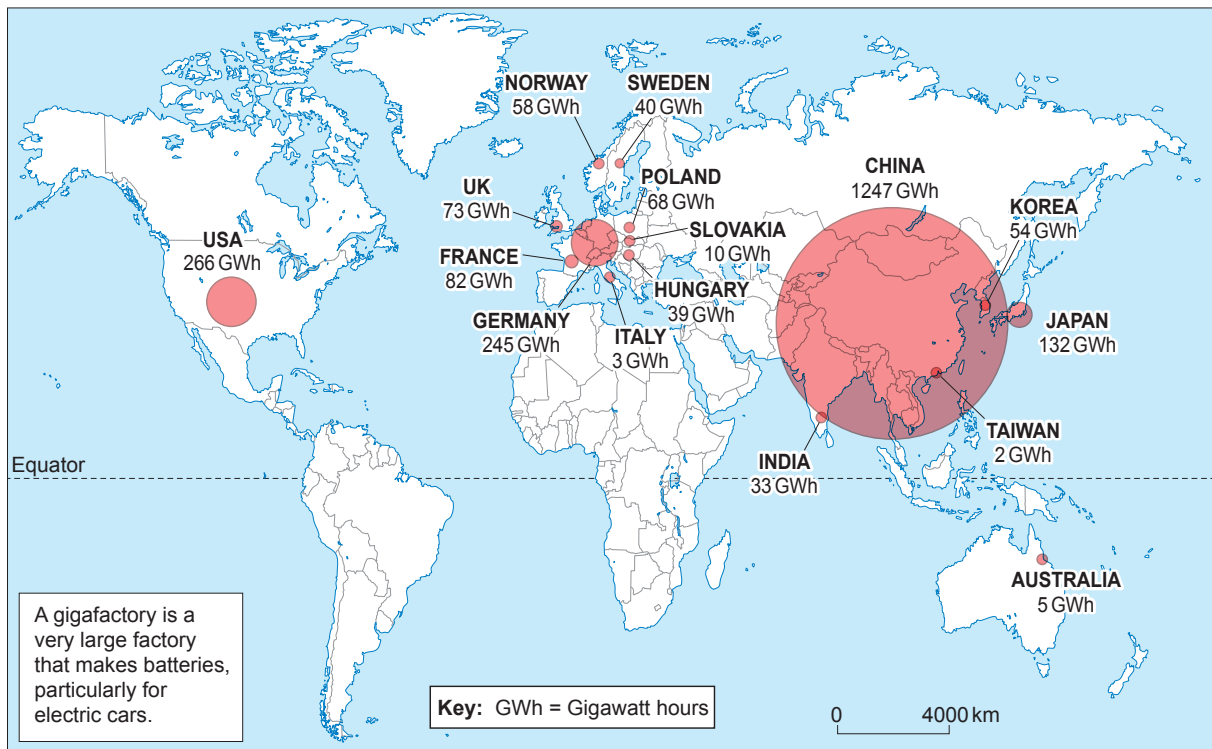


Figure 7 – Global gigafactory battery production



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
